

# What is Month of the Military Child?

In 1986, Defense Secretary Caspar Weinberger established "Month of the Military Child".

The month of April is the designated month celebrated across all military branches, which is why "purple" represents each branches' colors. Each year, the President issues a proclamation recognizing the significance of the Month of the Military Child. In addition, each state recognizes the month, as well as a dedicated date, to "Purple Up" as a part of the celebration this year, April 19 will be the official date for the state of Arizona.



#### BECOME A LICENSED FCC PROVIDER

The FCC program is looking for new providers for infants and children, two-weeks to 12 yrs. old, including children with special needs, for day, night, and weekend scheduling. Spouses of active duty, retired military members, DoD civilians and other individuals affiliated with DoD, upon review, living both on and off base, are eligible to become licensed FCC providers. Individuals interested in operating an FCC home must be at least 18 years of age, speak, read, and write English, have a high school diploma/GED, be able to pass background checks, and attend required trainings. To provide child care for more than ten hours per week on a regular basis while living in base housing, you must be licensed through the FCC office. 


