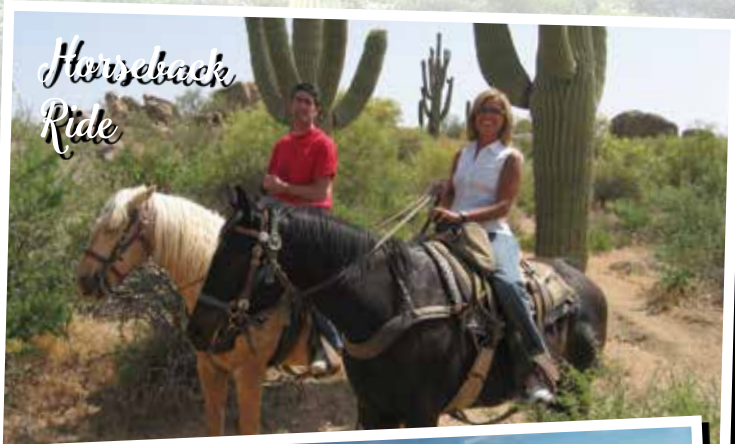

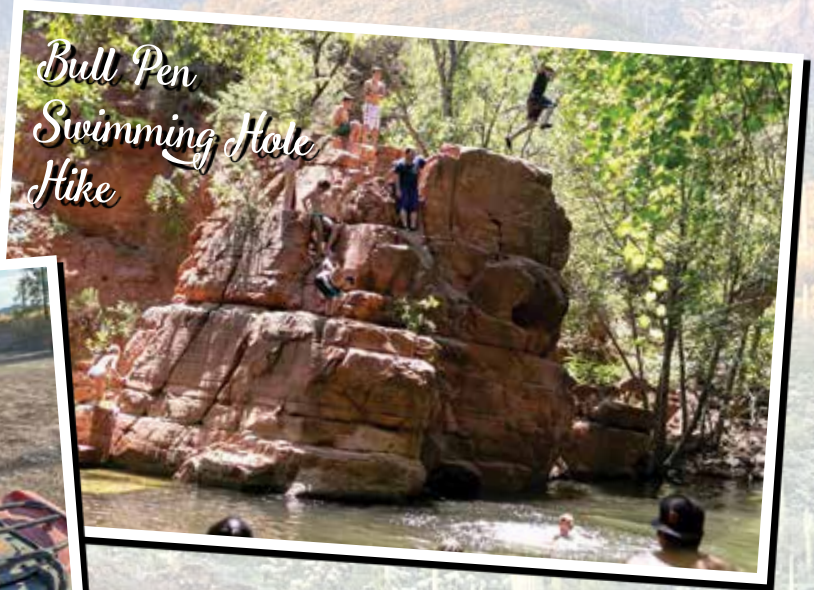

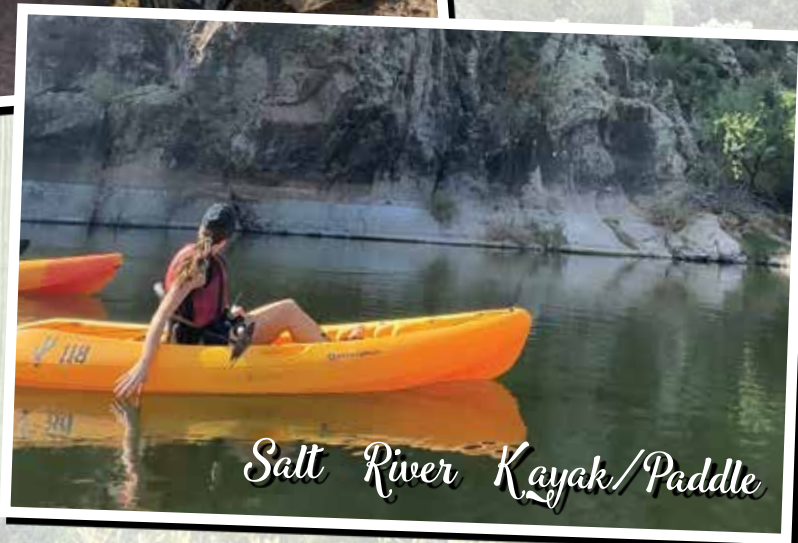

BECOME A LICENSED FCC PROVIDER

The FCC program is looking for new providers for infants and children, two-weeks to 12 yrs. old, including children with special needs, for day, night, and weekend scheduling. Spouses of active duty, retired military members, DoD civilians and other individuals affiliated with DoD, upon review, living both on and off base, are eligible to become licensed FCC providers. Individuals interested in operating an FCC home must be at least 18 years of age, speak, read, and write English, have a high school diploma/GED, be able to pass background checks, and attend required trainings. *To provide child care for more than ten hours per week on a regular basis while living in base housing, you must be licensed through the FCC office.* Call the FCC office, or e-mail: kimberly.kerr.2@us.af.mil, or visit: militarychildcare.com

FULL and PART-TIME CHILD CARE AVAILABLE

Childcare spots are available with on- and off-base FCC providers. Subsidized weekly rates are available to qualifying participants.

SPOUSE APPOINTMENT CHILD CARE

Military spouses may qualify for free childcare for job interviews/orientation, appointments, and classes they may have, through FCC.

Active-duty or Reserve/Guard (*active status*) personnel assigned to Luke, can receive 16-hours of free child care - per child. Child care hours may be used before, during, and after a contingency operation deployment, or if a member is deployed for a minimum of 30 calendar days, or if personnel are routinely deployed on a short-term basis.

NEW PROVIDER ORIENTATION

New Providers who have submitted their applications can attend to fulfill their training requirements. For those who qualify, childcare through the New Provider orientation Program, is provided, free of charge, on space available within an FCC home.

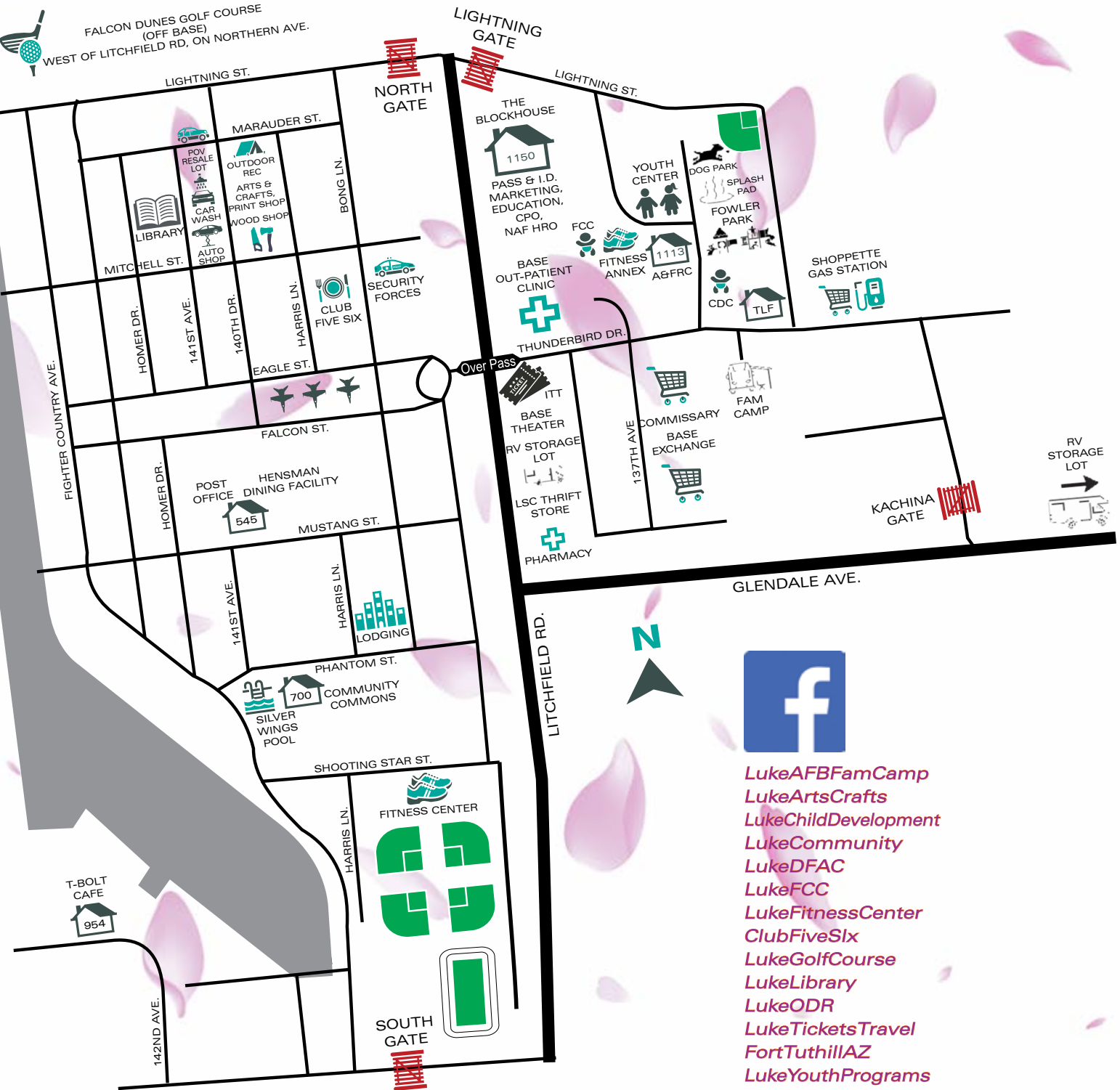

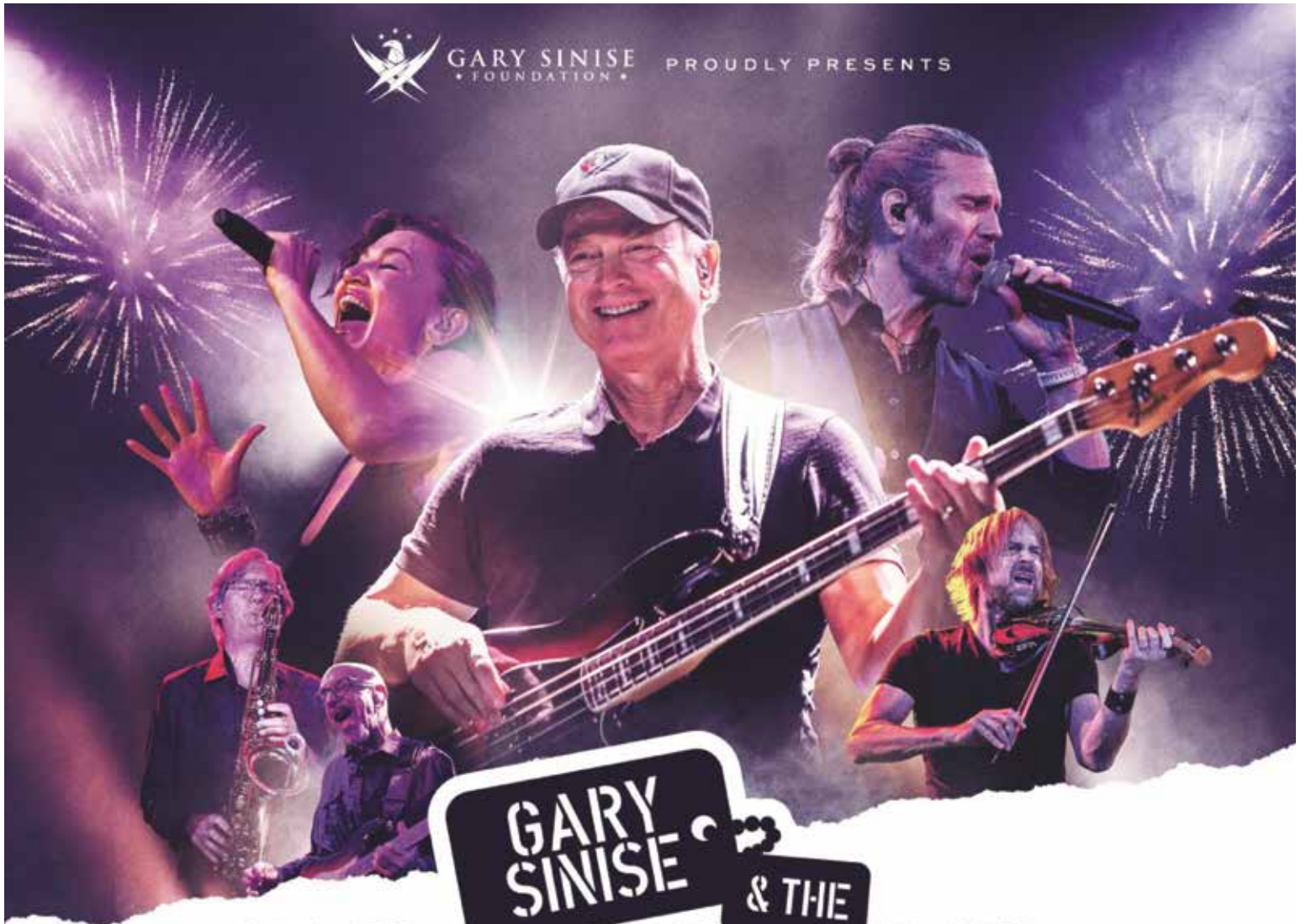
