# Employee Spotlight

The 56th Force Support Squadron's Marketing office is losing a valuable member this month, as our long-time graphic designer, Douglas Hickins, retires after a 30+ year career here at Luke AFB. As we say farewell, we thought it would be interesting to include a little background for our readers about Mr. Hickins.

*Tell us a little about yourself and your career.*

I was born and raised in Hastings, Nebraska, and I'm a fifth-generation Nebraskan. I attended Kearney State College - now the University of Nebraska at Kearney - for five years, majoring in Art, where I received a Bachelor of Fine Arts - BFA - degree.

While I've technically been working since I was 12 years old, I began my "adulting" career after graduating college in 1980. I've only had three jobs in the last 43 years.

My first job after graduation, was at Cornhusker Press, a large full-service print shop located in my hometown, where I learned the basics of graphic design. I designed everything from wedding invitations, forms, newsletters, calendars, catalogs, magazines, books, and more. In those days, everything was done by hand - computers wouldn't even be part of the industry for another 13 years. We worked at large drafting tables to create our projects, and my job title was Paste-up Artist.

After working there for five years, I decided to move here to Arizona in 1985.

My next job was at Pueblo Publishers in Glendale, publishers of the Glendale Star and Peoria Times newspapers, again as a paste-up artist. In addition, we published a number of high-school newspapers, and other local publications, but, we also composed and printed the weekly "Tally-Ho" newspaper, the original name of the current base newspaper the "Thunderbolt".

I had been working at Pueblo Publishers for eight years when computers were just becoming prevalent in the publishing industry. I could see the *writing-on-the-wall*, and realized that being a paste-up artist was a job soon to be obsolete. It was just at that time that the graphic designer - *technically: Visual Information Specialist* - position for the 56FSS Marketing office became available here at Luke, and I applied for the position.

While I didn't even know how to turn-on a computer, and had never been affiliated with the



military, I won the position based on my extensive art and graphic design background, and knowledge of the print industry. I was 37 years old when I began my job here on Nov. 29, 1993.

I was surprised to realize that the "Special Events Calendar" as "theBOLT" Magazine was called in those days, was only a four-page newsletter, and all of the FSS facilities weren't even included in the publication.

I set about building and expanding the publication, - *which was at the direction of my supervisor* - building relationships with the FSS facility managers, and including all FSS programs and base-wide events. TheBOLT Magazine, is now a 20-28 page full-color magazine.

In addition to this, I was also doing all other design work for FSS facilities, composing the "AtEase" which was a four-page monthly FSS supplement to the base newspaper, creating postings for three electronic marquees located around base - now part of the Public Affairs office, and purchasing agent for the Marketing office.

Over the years I've also done design work for the Marketing Office Print Shop, which was/is open to the base population - now located at Arts & Crafts - and worked at many, many FSS base-wide events including SpringFests, 4th of July's, OktoberFests, FallFests, Holiday Magics, and Luke Days.

Of course I didn't do anything completely by myself, and I've had the privilege of working with many dedicated and talented individuals, whom I consider my friends, here in Marketing and throughout the Force Support Squadron. I've often said that taking this job saved my life, as my career as a paste-up artist was ending and I had no idea what to do next.

I have enjoyed working here for 56FSS and Luke, and I'm excited for the next chapter of my life, with many plans and hobbies to keep me busy and active during my retirement.

Thank you so much for the memories.
